## **Event Planning Guide**

#### About Cervical Cancer Prevention Day

Cervical Cancer Prevention Day, launched in 2022 is observed annually on 21st May. It serves as a critical reminder of the urgent need to address one of the most preventable forms of cancer affecting women worldwide.

For the 2025–27 campaign cycle, the chosen theme – "Prevent Today, Protect Tomorrow" – underscores the importance of timely action through awareness, vaccination, and regular screening to secure a healthier future for women and girls.

#### Who Can Organize an Event?

- NGOs, Community-Service Organizations (CSOs)
- Hospitals, Health Clinics, Medical Colleges
- Schools, Colleges, Universities
- CSR Teams, Women's Collectives, Youth Groups
- Anyone who wishes to raise awareness about cervical cancer

#### **Suggested Event Formats**

#### 1. Awareness Sessions & Health Talks

- Host a session with a doctor, nurse, or health educator
- Include Q&A with real stories or survivor voices
- Cover topics like HPV vaccination, screening guidelines, symptoms, and myths

#### 2. Free Screening or Vaccination Camp

- Offer Pap smear or VIA screening for eligible women (ages 30-65)
- Organize HPV vaccination for adolescent girls (9–14 years)
- Partner with local hospitals or government health departments

#### 3. School/College Engagement

- Host poster-making, debates, or awareness quizzes
- Conduct peer education or student-led talks
- Distribute age-appropriate educational materials

#### 4. Social Media & Digital Outreach

- Use the campaign toolkit to post messages on Facebook, Instagram, WhatsApp & LinkedIn
- Share reels, infographics, survivor quotes
- User #CervicalCancerPreventionDay #CCPD2025 #CCPD

#PreventTodayProtectTomorrow and tag relevant partners to amplify reach

## **Event Planning Guide**

#### 5. Community Rally / Awareness Walk

- Organize a short community walk with placards and chants
- Involve ASHA workers, volunteers, health workers
- Distribute pamphlets and encourage open dialogue

#### What You'll Need

- Event venue (community hall, school ground, clinic, etc.)
- Speaker(s) medical expert, survivor, local influencer
- Outreach material (from Campaign toolkit: posters, social media posts, logos)
- · Banner with campaign theme
- Registration and consent forms for screening/vaccination
- · Refreshments and first-aid for attendees

#### **Planning Timeline**

- 2-3 weeks before: Finalize concept, date, venue, speaker, partners
- 1 week before: Promote through posters, WhatsApp groups, social handles
- Event Day (May 21): Execute and document the event
- Post-event (May 22+): Share photos, stories, and feedback online using relevant #s and tagging partners
